

Closing Open Doors (Repentance & Forgiveness) Deliverance Prayer

(James 4:7; Ephesians 4:26–27; Matthew 6:14–15; 1 John 1:9, NKJV)

Repent

Heavenly Father, I come humbly before You in the mighty name of Jesus Christ. I repent for every sin, compromise, and rebellion that has opened doors to the enemy in my life. I confess anger, bitterness, unforgiveness, sexual sin, fear, pride, rebellion, and any participation in occult curiosity. I ask You to wash me clean by the blood of Jesus, forgive my sins, and restore me to right standing with You.

Renounce

In Jesus' name, I renounce every sinful agreement, attitude, or action that has allowed the enemy access to my life. I renounce unforgiveness and every root of bitterness. I choose to forgive those who have hurt me—whether they asked for it or not. I release them to You, Lord, and break all ties of resentment, vengeance, or judgment.

Command

By the authority of Jesus Christ, I close every spiritual door I have opened through sin, trauma, or unbelief. I command every unclean spirit that entered through those doors to leave me now and go to the feet of Jesus. I submit to God and resist the devil, and he must flee (James 4:7). I break every foothold and claim of darkness, in Jesus' name.

Seal

Holy Spirit, fill every area that has now been cleansed. Seal every door with the blood of Jesus. Establish Your peace, purity, and holiness in my life. Let my house and heart become a dwelling place for Your presence. I declare freedom, forgiveness, and protection, in Jesus' mighty name. Amen.
