



Python Spirit Deliverance Prayer

■ Repent

Heavenly Father, I come before You in the mighty name of Jesus Christ, humbling myself at Your throne of grace. I acknowledge that You alone are the Lord who sets captives free. I repent for every sin that has opened the door to the spirit of Python—whether through rebellion, disobedience, pride, witchcraft, or ungodly covenants. I ask for Your forgiveness and cleansing through the blood of Jesus (1 John 1:9).

>■ Renounce

In the name of Jesus Christ, I renounce and break every agreement, covenant, and partnership I or my ancestors have made with the spirit of divination, witchcraft, or any python spirit. I renounce every ungodly practice, object, or ritual that has given this spirit legal ground. I sever all soul ties connected to divination, false prophecy, or spiritual bondage, declaring Jesus Christ as my Lord and Deliverer (2 Corinthians 6:14–18).

■ Command

In the mighty name of Jesus Christ, and by the authority given to me as a believer (Luke 10:19), I take authority over every python spirit operating in or around my life. I command every spirit of divination, constriction, and spiritual suffocation to loose me now and go to the abyss in Jesus' name! I break every chain, shackle, and constriction wrapped around my spirit, soul, and body. I declare the Word of the Lord: "No weapon formed against you shall prosper" (Isaiah 54:17). Every demonic power that has attempted to choke my prayer life, suffocate my spiritual growth, or block the move of the Holy Spirit—I command you to be uprooted and cast out in Jesus' name!

■ Seal

Father, I seal this deliverance with the blood of Jesus Christ. I close every door that was opened to the python spirit and declare that it will not return. I place the armor of God upon myself (Ephesians 6:10–18) and stand in Your truth, righteousness, and power. Let Your angels encamp around me and protect me (Psalm 34:7).
