

Spirit of Poverty Deliverance Prayer

Extended Version — Prayer Vault

Heavenly Father

I come before You in the mighty and victorious Name of Jesus Christ, my Lord and Savior. I thank You that through the finished work of the Cross, every curse has been broken and every demonic power has been defeated. I humble myself before You, acknowledging that You are my Source, my Provider, and the One who gives me power to get wealth, that Your covenant may be established (Deuteronomy 8:18).

Step 1: Repentance

Father, I repent for every sin, iniquity, and ungodly mindset that has opened the door to the spirit of poverty in my life and bloodline. I repent for fear, unbelief, selfishness, greed, stinginess, hoarding, lack of trust in Your provision, and any failure to tithe or give as You have instructed. I repent for every time I have spoken words of lack, doubt, and despair over my finances, family, and future. I repent for exalting mammon, worrying about tomorrow, and relying on my own strength instead of trusting You. I repent for any idolatry, covetousness, or envy toward others' prosperity. I repent for ancestral sins of debt, corruption, oppression of the poor, financial injustice, theft, gambling, bribery, and every unrighteous financial gain that has given legal ground to the enemy. Lord, I ask that You wash me clean by the blood of Jesus Christ. Let Your mercy triumph over judgment in my life. I choose this day to align my heart, words, and actions with Your Kingdom.

Step 2: Renunciation

In the Name of Jesus Christ, I now renounce and reject the spirit of poverty and all associated spirits — lack, fear of giving, fear of the future, greed, selfishness, mammon, debt, hopelessness, scarcity mindset, and every generational curse connected to financial bondage. I renounce every covenant, oath, dedication, or agreement made by me or my ancestors with demonic powers in the area of finances — knowingly or unknowingly. I renounce the mindset of poverty that says “ I will never have enough, ” “ this is just my lot, ” or “ I must hold back to survive. ” I declare that I will no longer walk in agreement with the lies of the enemy regarding my provision.

Step 3: Command / Spiritual Warfare

In the mighty Name of Jesus Christ, I now take authority over every unclean spirit assigned to enforce the spirit of poverty in my life. “ Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you. ” — Luke 10:19 (NKJV). I command every spirit of poverty, lack, debt, scarcity, fear, mammon, and financial oppression to come out of my life now in the Name of Jesus. I break every curse of lack, curse of holes in the bag (Haggai 1:6), and every generational financial curse operating in my bloodline. I break and destroy all satanic altars, covenants, legal claims, and witchcraft

assignments fueling financial bondage. I speak the fire of the Holy Spirit against every demonic chain holding my resources captive. I declare that the wealth of the wicked is laid up for the righteous, and I receive the transfer of Kingdom provision into my life, home, and ministry according to God ' s will.

Step 4: Sealing & Declaration of Blessing

Father, I thank You that whom the Son sets free is free indeed. I declare that I am redeemed from the curse of poverty, for Jesus became poor that I through His poverty might become rich (2 Corinthians 8:9). I choose to walk in Kingdom stewardship, generosity, faith, and obedience. I declare that my mind is renewed — I no longer live under fear or scarcity but under the blessing of Abraham through Christ Jesus (Galatians 3:13–14). I decree that: - My hands are blessed to prosper. - My storehouses shall overflow. - I will lend and not borrow. - I will give and it shall be given unto me, good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over. - I will honor the Lord with the firstfruits of all my increase, and my barns shall be filled with plenty (Proverbs 3:9–10). I seal this prayer in the blood of Jesus Christ, and I ask the Holy Spirit to fill every area where poverty once reigned with faith, wisdom, discipline, and Kingdom abundance.
